AP Human Geography:

- 1. Focus of study will be on the theme of Human Environment Interaction
 - a. Why cities develop where they are
 - b. Why cities develop the way they do
 - c. How development impacts the environment
 - d. The class will include "field studies" field trips to develop curriculum
 - e. Will include mapping, projects, etc...
- 2. AP = Advanced Placement
 - a. Summer assignment including reading and reports
 - b. There will be homework each night
 - c. Students will be encouraged to develop study groups
 - d. A textbook and workbook will be a part of the class but students will need to purchase an atlas and study guide.
 - e. Writing is a focus of the curriculum
 - f. Test in May for college credit (optional) This test DOES cost about \$85
- 3. Your ability to organize, to plan and think independently is essential.
- 4. AP will help you prepare for the rigor of college earlier and faster.
- 5. AP IS a college course, with college requirements, AND college expectations
- 6. You may take AP Human Geography AND geography if you choose.
- 7. Students who take AP will also be scheduled into a Honors Language Arts course to support the writing required in AP
- 8. You will need to decide within the first two weeks of school if you want to drop AP, otherwise you will stay in AP for the year.
- 9. Failure to complete the summer assignment will result in being dropped from the AP course.

Honors Language Arts and Geography:

- 1. Increased rigor (it is faster, harder, higher academic expectations)
- 2. More writing, reading, projects and homework
- 3. Your ability to organize, to plan and think independently is essential.

Biology:

- 1. Increased rigor (it is faster, harder, higher academic expectations)
- 2. More writing, reading and homework (about 2 pages typed each week)
- 3. Your ability to organize, to plan and think independently is essential.
- 4. You may take Biology AND Earth systems at the same time.
- 5. Research project each semester.
- 6. 45min.-1hr homework 3 nights a week.
- 7. You can only take Earth Systems in the 9th grade
- 8. You will need to decide within the first two weeks of school if you want to drop Biology, otherwise you will stay in Biology for the year.
