COUNSELING CENTER UPDATE

Ms. Harper informed the council that 9th grade College and Career Readiness (CCR) assessment meetings with all 9th grade parents and their students have begun, occurring from March 1, 2017 to April 5th 2017. The College Fair will be March 29th and West Hills and Copper Hills will also be invited to attend. Sophomore orientation for Copper Hills will be March 3rd with 2 sessions to choose from, 5pm or 7pm. The counseling center just completed a Celebrate Diversity Contest, winners will be announced soon.

The question was asked, "When are the Honor Society Invites sent to parents?" Mr. Urry indicated they are sent during the 4th quarter

VOTING ITEM: DISTRIBUTION PLAN FOR REMAINDER OF 2016-2017 TRUST LAND FUNDS

Mr. Urry reviewed the budget vs. actual expenses year to date. As of 2/24/17, \$94.3K has been spent leaving \$100.5K remaining. After reviewing remainder year expenses, Mr. Urry proposed purchasing 6 more Chrome book labs and carts at an estimated cost of \$74K. Mr. Urry then went through other requests received from teachers. The council held a healthy discussion regarding all the areas the funds could be used to assist kids academically. Ms. Southworth then proposed a vote on purchasing 6 Chrome book labs and carts, the motion was seconded by Ms. Greenwood. A vote was then taken and all present unanimously approved the purchase. Mr. Urry will now take the request to the Jordan School District Board to approve. Mr. Urry did indicate he may have money in the technology budget to purchase 3 of the 6 Chrome book labs.

VOTING ITEM: 2016-2017 SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Mr. Urry discussed the 2016-2017 School Plan. Normally this plan is approved at the beginning of the school year, but due to an oversight that vote did not occur. The council discussed possible focus areas for the 2017-2018 plan, then tabled the discussion until next meeting due
