5. Meet with a group of counselors for an interview, talking about why you want to be an ambassador.

Ambassador Requirements:

1. You must take and abide by the anti-bully pledge. Reciting this will be a TA assignment next year.
2. Maintain S and H Citizenship grades. If you receive an N or a U, you will be placed on probation.
3. Maintain a 2.0 GPA.
4. Keep your grades up. If you receive an F, you will be placed on probation.
5. You need to be comfortable talking to people and/or willing to practice a lot.
6. You need to be willing to work on a variety of projects and travel to our Elementary schools to perform and teach lessons.
