Goals/Objectives:	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Define bullying and the types of bullying. 2. Provide examples of how to prevent bullying from the witness, victim, & bully point of view. 3. Help students identify if a situation is bullying or a group of kids being rude. 	
<p>Procedures:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A printed copy of the PowerPoint used in this lesson is available in your binder. It goes over some basics of bullying. 2. Pass out the 3 Ps of bullying handout. Go through the powerpoint with your students. 3. PLEASE EMPHASIZE – we will be doing the pledge banner during lunch tomorrow and we would love every student to commit to not bullying. 4. Go over the case studies with the students. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The case study with Gina is bullying. Talk about this with your students and brainstorm what they could do to deal with this situation. b. The case study with Mia and Jessica isn't bullying. It is students being rude. Since it only happened once, talk about what Mia and Jessica could have done when the boys were being rude. c. The case study with Kevin is bullying. Talk about this with your students and brainstorm what they could do to deal with this situation. 5. If you have extra time, please talk about different kinds of bullying your students have seen and what they can do to deal with it or prevent it.
