- Implement research-based middle level best practices that are developmentally responsive and socially equitable through research, planning, parental involvement and professional learning communities.
- Increase the use and implementation of instructional technology school-wide.

#### **Planned Steps:**

- Increase Proficiency Goal:
  - o Continue to fund part-time staff/teachers as intervention aides
  - o Continue to fund part-time staff/teachers as math assistants and/or a math tutors
  - \*\*\*All remaining goals directly support this goal
- RTI Goal:
  - o Fund part-time staff for intervention implementation and monitoring (RTI)
  - o Purchase hardware for RTI implementation
- Developmentally Responsive/Socially Equitable goal:
  - o Provide and/or pay for staff inservice, professional development and collaboration opportunities
  - Purchase research materials (books, software) for staff inservice (professional learning communities)
- Technology Goal:
  - Purchase technology hardware and software as needed (data projectors, document camera's, etc.)
  - o Provide staff inservice for effective implementation of instructional technology

#### **Measuring Progress Toward Goals:**

- Track CRT improvement in science, math and language arts for overall school improvement as well as performance in sub categories to close the achievement gap.
- Track the results of the indicators of School Quality Survey Tool to measure parental involvement (Epstein's Six Traits).
- Evaluate the effectiveness of the Response to Intervention/Pyramid of Interventions by tracking the number of students earning D's and F's each quarter.
- Use annual technology surveys to determine technology needs for classrooms, computer labs and also to evaluate staff technology skill levels.

#### **School Improvement Plan:**

- The School Land Trust Plan is directly in line with our school improvement plan. Our school improvement plan goals are:
  - 1. Increase the number of students at level 3 and 4 on the language arts, science, and math CRT by 2% per year
  - 2. Hold high academic standards for each and every student.
  - 3. Create a middle school that is collaborative, developmentally responsive, and socially equitable.
