- District has been paying for bussing to Sycamores that they weren't required to pay for
- Bussing to Sycamores will terminate when light is built

- Also paying for 4 hours of extra of police observation
- Can't put crossing guard at the location
- Will be doing speed study
- Ultimately want sky bridges funded by special project by legislation
