Math Tips & Suggestions

1. Class notes—may take the place of textbooks on some topics
 - Detailed, neat and organized is a must
 - Make up notes when absent—from friend, classmate, teacher's website (if available)
2. School Planner
 - Use the planner to record assignments
 - Plan ahead for projects and tests
